Dear Parents/Guardians

The attached sheet outlines the payments set by Noble Park Secondary College Council for the 2008 school year.

Subject Contributions

The Subject Contributions charge of \$180.00, is requested to supplement government funds and to enable us to provide the high quality programs that you rightfully expect for your child.

This charge contributes to classroom running costs such as class texts and materials, library books, as well as more general College items such as College Newsletters, parent notices, first aid supplies and student welfare programs.

This charge does not include costs of excursions, camps and tours, or any booklist items.

IT Consumables

This charge helps to provide Software Site Licences, printer cartridges, paper, maintenance of printers and photocopiers which are a considerable expense to the College.

Student Diary

It is College policy that all students purchase the Student Diary. This planner is used to teach students time management skills, including planning their homework and being organised to complete unit requirements by due dates. It also provides a means of communication between teachers and parents.

ID Cards

It is College policy that all students have an Identification Card. We require that students purchase in ID card at Year 7, Year 9 and Year 11 at a current cost of \$5.00. Students require an ID card for various activities within the College. All students must have an ID card to obtain a Travel Concession Card for public transport. If an ID card is lost or damaged it must be replaced. The cost for replacement is also \$5.00.

Sport Excursions

As part of the Health and PE Key Learning area, and the Government's compulsory sports requirements, all students are required to participate in sport activities. These include the swimming and athletics sports days and other interschool sports days throughout the year.
